The Wahnetah Orchestra

The sharp looking group of men pictured above, the Wahnetah Orchestra, was perhaps Hillsborough's most popular mascal group for over thirty years. Organized in 1889, it featured some of Hillsborough's most skilled musicians and prominers citizens. In addition to playing at sarious shores and dancer on Hillsborough, the orchestra played for every Hillsborough High School graduation from 1890 through the 1920s. The group played in situally every town in southern New Hampshire including shows in 1897 and 1898 at Lake Surapee on the steamship "Winena". The phenograph dates from account the turn of the 20° century and shows in members at that time. A classy looking bunch indeed!
